Camping

The black horse festival Campsite is a new venture and one of the new facilities to move the festival forward into the 21st century. There will be a limited number of spaces on the campsite which can only be booked and accessed by people with full-weekend tickets (no camping is available for day ticket holders).

Access is available from 12.00 noon on 28th May and all tents must be clear by 10.00am on Tuesday 1st June.

The campsite is only available to tents, no caravans or campers.

Our campsite will have limited facilities but will have toilets and running water. There are a couple of showers within the pestalozzi village which are accessible.

No animals (except guide dogs will be allowed on the site at any time)

FIRES & COOKING: You are allowed to have a small barbecue in the camping field, provided that the fire is contained within a purpose built barbecue, which is well off the ground so it will not damage the grass. You must have a bucket of water or fire extinguishers near to the barbecue at all times whilst in use, and not leave any barbecue or cooking appliance unattended until it is completely cold.

There is no vehicular access to the camping site but the car park is very close to the campsite.

The camp site will be secure with security 24 hours a day and due to our licence there will be no live or recorded music of anytime after 00.30am
